

## ROAD CLOSURES AND RESTRICTIONS RACE START TIME: 09:30 ROUTE CLOSURES FROM: 06:00

Marathon Yorkshire are pleased to, once again, be working in partnership with City of York Council, Ryedale District Council, North Yorkshire County Council and East Riding of Yorkshire Council to deliver the Yorkshire Marathon including the Yorkshire 10 Mile.


In accordance with traffic authority regulations for the City of York, North Yorkshire and East Riding of Yorkshire, an order has been made prohibiting and restricting the use of certain roads and road junctions in order to facilitate the safe holding of the Yorkshire Marathon and Yorkshire 10 Mile. The events will require the closure of roads and road junctions as well as the suspension of a number of Traffic Regulation Orders between 10:00 on Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> October and 23:00 on Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> October 2025. Parking suspensions and a tow order will be in place across the route.

Affected roads and areas on route are detailed below along with approximate closure timings. Roads have been grouped into coloured zones - please see the route map overleaf. Any roads either crossing or having a junction with the listed roads will also be closed at that point. All times are approximate and subject to change. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained throughout the event. Please note that there will be a number of entertainment points on the route – noise levels will be raised at these locations.
